## **Safety Information**

**WARNING:** Please read all safety instructions before beginning installation.

- Always disconnect the vehicle's battery before starting installation
- Do not install while the vehicle is running
- Ensure all connections are secure to prevent electrical hazards
- If you are not comfortable with automotive electrical work, consult a professional installer
- Keep the device away from excessive heat, moisture, and direct sunlight
- Do not disassemble the device this will void the warranty

**IMPORTANT:** Installation may affect your vehicle's warranty. Check with your dealer before proceeding.

# **Package Contents**

# **System Requirements**

### **Vehicle Requirements**

- 12V DC power supply
- Available dashboard mounting space (minimum 7 inches width)
- Access to vehicle's USB port or 12V outlet

### **Device Compatibility**

- iPhone 6 or newer with iOS 9.0 or later
- Android devices with Android Auto support (Android 6.0 or later)
- Wireless connectivity: Bluetooth 5.0 and Wi-Fi 2.4GHz/5GHz

#### **Pre-Installation Checklist**

Before beginning installation, complete the following steps:

#### 1. Choose Installation Location

- Select a location within easy reach of the driver
- Ensure the screen doesn't obstruct important vehicle controls
- Verify adequate ventilation around the device
- Check that cables can reach power source

#### 2. Gather Required Tools

- Phillips head screwdriver
- Flat head screwdriver
- Wire strippers (if hardwiring)
- Multimeter (recommended)
- Clean cloth for surface preparation

#### 3. Vehicle Preparation

- Park on level ground with parking brake engaged
- Turn off engine and remove keys
- Disconnect negative battery terminal
- Clean the intended mounting surface

# **Installation Steps**

### **Step 1: Mounting the Display**

#### 1. Position the Mounting Bracket

- Hold the bracket against your chosen location
- Mark screw holes with a pencil
- Ensure the bracket is level using a bubble level

#### 2. Secure the Bracket

- For dashboard mounting: Use provided screws (avoid over-tightening)
- For adhesive mounting: Clean surface with alcohol, apply adhesive tape, press firmly for 30 seconds

#### 3. Attach the Display

- Slide the display onto the mounting bracket
- Ensure the display clicks securely into place
- Test that the display can be adjusted to your preferred viewing angle

### Step 2: Power Connection

### **Option A: 12V Outlet Connection (Recommended for beginners)**

- 1. Connect the power cable to the device
- 2. Plug the 12V connector into your vehicle's power outlet
- 3. Route the cable neatly using the provided cable clips

#### **Option B: Hardwired Connection (Advanced users)**

- 1. Locate a suitable 12V power source (fuse box recommended)
- 2. Connect the red wire to positive (+) 12V switched power
- 3. Connect the black wire to negative (-) ground
- 4. Use a fuse rated at 5A on the positive connection
- 5. Secure all connections with electrical tape or heat shrink tubing

#### **Step 3: Data Connection**

#### 1. **USB Connection**

- Connect the USB-C cable to the device
- Connect the other end to your vehicle's USB port (if available)
- This enables faster phone charging when connected

#### 2. Cable Management

- Use the provided cable clips to secure cables
- Avoid routing cables where they may interfere with vehicle operation
- Ensure cables are not pinched or stretched

### **Step 4: Final Installation Check**

- 1. Reconnect the vehicle's battery
- 2. Start the vehicle and verify the display powers on
- 3. Check that all cables are secure and properly routed
- 4. Ensure the display doesn't obstruct any vehicle controls or warning lights

# **First Time Setup**

#### **Initial Power On**

#### 1. Device Startup

- Turn on your vehicle
- The HAUXIY display should automatically power on
- Wait for the startup sequence to complete (approximately 30 seconds)

#### 2. Language Selection

- Select your preferred language from the menu
- Choose your region/country for proper app compatibility

### **Connecting Your iPhone (CarPlay)**

#### 1. Enable CarPlay on iPhone

- Go to Settings > General > CarPlay
- Ensure CarPlay is enabled

#### 2. Wireless Connection

- On the HAUXIY display, select "CarPlay" from the main menu
- On your iPhone, go to Settings > Wi-Fi
- Look for "HAUXIY-CarPlay" network and connect
- Follow the on-screen pairing instructions

#### 3. Bluetooth Pairing

- The device will automatically prompt for Bluetooth pairing
- Accept the pairing request on your iPhone
- CarPlay should now be active

### **Connecting Your Android Device**

#### 1. Enable Android Auto

- Ensure Android Auto app is installed and updated
- Enable Developer Options and USB Debugging (if required)

#### 2. Wireless Connection

- Select "Android Auto" from the main menu
- Follow the on-screen instructions to connect via Wi-Fi
- Complete the pairing process as prompted

# **Troubleshooting**

#### **Common Issues and Solutions**

#### Display won't turn on

- Check power connections
- Verify vehicle's 12V outlet is working
- Ensure battery is properly connected
- · Check fuse if hardwired

#### Phone won't connect

- Restart both the device and your phone
- Clear Bluetooth cache on your phone
- Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled on your phone
- Try forgetting and re-pairing the connection

#### **Poor audio quality**

- Check Bluetooth connection strength
- Restart the device
- Ensure phone is within 3 feet of the display
- Update your phone's software

#### **Touchscreen not responsive**

- Clean the screen with a soft, dry cloth
- Restart the device
- Check for software updates
- Ensure the screen isn't damaged

### **CarPlay/Android Auto frequently disconnects**

- Keep phone closer to the device
- Check for interference from other wireless devices
- Restart both devices
- Update phone software and CarPlay/Android Auto apps

### **Advanced Troubleshooting**

#### **Factory Reset**

- 1. Hold the power button for 10 seconds while device is on
- 2. Select "Factory Reset" from the menu
- 3. Confirm the reset
- 4. Reconfigure all settings

#### **Software Updates**

- 1. Connect to Wi-Fi network
- 2. Go to Settings > System Update
- 3. Download and install any available updates
- 4. Restart the device after update completion

#### **Maintenance**

### **Regular Maintenance Tasks**

### Monthly:

- Clean the screen with a microfiber cloth
- Check all cable connections
- Verify mounting bracket security

#### **Quarterly:**

- Check for software updates
- Clean ventilation areas
- Inspect cables for wear or damage

### **Annually:**

- Professional inspection recommended
- Check mounting hardware
- Verify electrical connections

### **Cleaning Instructions**

- Use only soft, lint-free cloths
- Slightly dampen cloth with water or appropriate screen cleaner
- Never use harsh chemicals, abrasives, or excessive moisture
- Allow to dry completely before use

# **Warranty Information**

### **Warranty Coverage**

• Duration: 12 months from date of purchase

• Coverage: Manufacturing defects and component failures

• Exclusions: Damage from misuse, accidents, unauthorized modifications
